## **1** Actions

Read ("R") (read it)

Add ("A") (add , not a page)

Addw-app ("Aw") (add stuff after approval, not a page)

Update ("U") (change it in any way you like, except deleting the whole page

Create ("C") (create a page)

**Delete** (**''D''**) (delete the page)

## 2 Roles

We distinguish the following roles (a person can have several roles): Each user is assigned one or more roles. The role is the basic for access rights (see below). Roles are to be defined by the administrator (=webmaster).

Administrator=Webmaster (has full permission) - can be more than one!

EC-Member Member of the Executive Committee

Board member Designated representative of a specific Member Society to the IFSR Board

C-P-Member Member of a Committee

- Note: Currently no extra permissions are envisioned for the chairpersons of committees/projects
- **VIP** Important person somewhat "belonging" zu IFSR although not in an official position 'at the moment'. Typically past-presidents of Member societies etc. They could also be important representatives of other societies. They might be given more permissions than ('simple') registered visitors.

### **3** Categories of Web-Pages

Categorisation is useful for logical understanding and has no immediate effects on the behaviour of the Website.

- **IFSR-public** contains stable info on organisation etc. and pointers to other pages. Modification is strongly controlled, reading is generally permitted
- **IFSR-announce** contains shortlived info on events, related to the IFSR. Modification permitted for a wide number of plersons, little control, reading generally permitted
- **IFSR-Outreach** These are pages where sister organisations etc. may announce their events, projects etc.
- **IFSR-EC** restricted access! It is confidential to the EC. Contains info related to the operation of the EC, sensitive information, info not-ready for publication etc.
- **IFSR-Board** restricted access! Access only to a limited set of priviledged persons. Contains details of IFSR operations not designed for the general public, e.g. budget information, strategies, evaluations.
- IFSR-C-P restricted access! Pages of a specific committee or project.

### 4 Specific Web-Pages

In this secction we list the actually planned web pages in a logical order. They will be assigned to categories (section 3) and are marked by  $\ll ... \gg$ . We assume that specific material (e.g. web pages of member societies, detailed up-to-date information of the journal will be maintained *outside* of the IFSR-web-site.

### **Events**

- **IFSR-General Information** : « *Category: IFSR-public* » Governance, Constitution, Mission, Aims, ...
- **IFSR Organisation** : « *Category: IFSR-public* » IFSR Structure, Officers, Contact Points
- **Recognitions** : « *Category: IFSR-public* » only IFSR related recognitions, e.g. honoray members, etc.
- **IFSR Operation** *« Category: IFSR-public »* Dates of EC and Board Meetings, together with Agenda, i.e. official and public information
- **IFSR projects and committees** *« Category: IFSR-public »* A set of Pages per committee/per Project. It will show the Name, short description, Pointer, Achievements, ways to contribute, etc. plus pointer to the projects individual pages, which are to be maintained by the project/committee andare not necessarily located on the IFSR-website. The following Projects/Committees are already envisioned:

#### **Fuschl Committee**

ESCO - Electronic Encyclopedia Committee

International Academy of Cybernetics and Systems Research :

- Member Societies' Directory : « *Category: IFSR-public* » List of Members together with a VERY short description (maximum 1/4 of page) plus RATHER STABLE information on the society: a contact person. Additionally it will contain a **link to the member society's own web-site** which is not under the responsibility of the IFSR. *All other information should be kept on the member society's home page and maintained by the member itself*!
- **IFSR Announcements** Special Events Announcements: « *Category: IFSR-announce* » Pointers to other web-sites should be used.
- Events : « *Category: IFSR-announce* » e.g. KOBE-Conference and the 25 year Celebration.
- **IFSR Fora** Pages specific to a group of people within IFSR, usually not intended for the general public and therefore inaccessible to others. used for exchanging internal information
  - **IFSR-EC-Forum** *« Category: IFSR-EC »* info exchange within the IFSR-EC
  - **IFSR-Board-Forum** « *Category: IFSR-Board* » info exchange of the IFSR-Board (the designated represeantatives of the Member Societies)
  - **IFSR Projects/Committees Fora** :« *Category: IFSR-Board* » To be used for internal interactive discussions etc. within the Committees/Projects. At the moment we lump alls committees and projects into one category and give it the same accessibility like the IFSR-Board-Forum, assuming that there will be no transgressions.
- **IFSR Publications** : Links to our dissemination vehicles. Details should go onto separate pages, which are to be maintained by the individual responsibles for the respective dissemination vehicle.
  - **Journal of Systems Research and Behavioral Science Section** : *« Category: IFSRpublic »*

**IFSR Book Series Section** : *« Category: IFSR-public »* 

- **IFSR Newsletter Section** : « *Category: IFSR-public* » past Newsletters and announcement of new ones
- **Outreach pages** : « *Category: IFSR-announce* » This will connect to other organisations and events
  - **Sister Societies** : Here some communication/association with 'friendly organisations' should be places. Examples are IIASA, candidate members, ...
