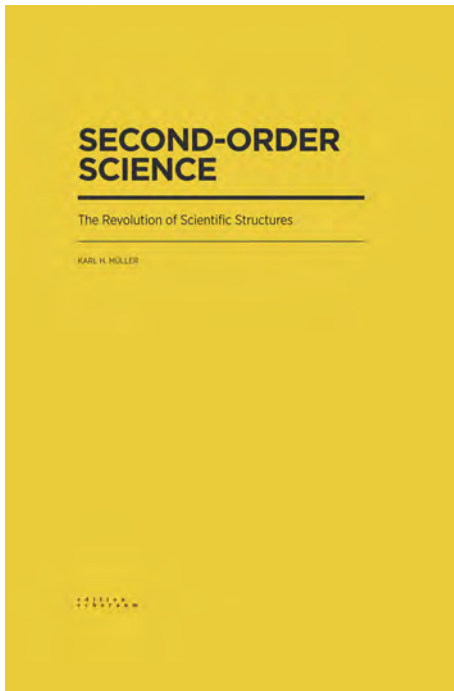


# New Books on Second-Order Science

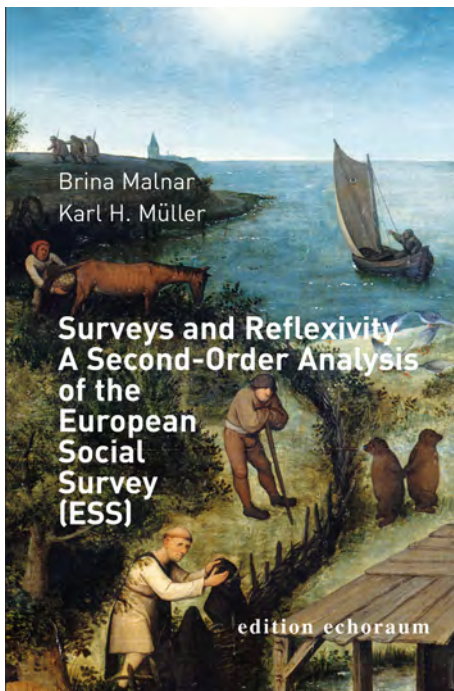
